ABOUT HARYANA HISTORY CONGRESS

Haryana History Congress, an academic organization working on different issues on Haryana histories and culture and so on. The HHC was established in February 2016. The Congress has organized seven sessions successfully at various institutions, colleges, and universities. It is purely a non-political organization. The main aim of HHC is to develop the understanding of the history and culture of Haryana. It also endeavours to highlight the Indian history without any bias and prejudice.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The aims and objectives of Haryana History Congress are:

- a) To create awareness about the recent trends in historical and archaeological research.
- b) To promote scientific temperament for historical research.

- c) To promote research in various historical themes and publication of proceedings, books, journals etc.
- d) To promote awareness of preservation of historical monuments, archaeological sites and historical research in Haryana in particular and India in general.
- e) To promote, preserve, rediscover and revive the tangible and intangible heritage.
- f) Providing awards of excellence to invaluable historical research.
- g) To promote ideas of cultural pluralism, peace and unity in diversity.
- h) To establish and promote relations with versatile scholars of different streams of various regions.
- i) To organize national/international conferences, seminars, lectures, symposia, workshops, debates, heritage tours, cultural festivals, and awareness programs among the masses.
- j) To bring out Journals, Proceedings, Magazines, Pamphlets, Periodicals, and Newsletters etc. in English and Hindi languages.
- k) To provide grants and donations to innovative organizations/institutions for the promotion of achieving aims and objectives of HHC.

MEMBERSHIP AND REGISTRATION FEE

1. **Annual Membership:** Any person having faith in the aims and objectives of Haryana History Congress is eligible for becoming the annual member of HHC. Annual membership Fee is ₹ 500 (Five hundred). After becoming the annual member of HHC, the delegates are supposed to pay a registration fee of ₹ 500. **The total amount to be paid- ₹ 1000 (One thousand)** (membership fee ₹ 500 + conference registration fee ₹ 500).
2. **Life Membership:** Any person having faith in the aims and objectives of Haryana History Congress is eligible for becoming the life member of HHC. Life membership Fee is ₹ 3500/- (three thousand five hundred). After becoming a life member of HHC, the delegates are supposed to pay a registration fee of ₹ 500. **The total amount to be paid- ₹ 4000/- (Four thousand)** (membership fee ₹ 3500 + conference registration fee ₹ 500).

FACILITATION FOR DELEGATES

- The HHC will provide a certificate for participation as well as paper presentation to all delegates
- A hard copy of proceedings will be provided free of cost for all delegates.
- Haryana History Congress kit having- pen, notepad, program schedule and badge are given to all delegates.
- Presidential addresses (pamphlets) of different sections i.e. ancient, medieval, modern and general presidential addresses are provided to all delegates.
- Information regarding filling of Google form, details regarding membership and registration fees for attending the conference will be provided in the Second Circular which is to be published in near future.

PRIZES FOR BEST PAPERS

Four best paper awards to be given in Haryana History Congress are as follows:

- **Professor R.C. Thakran Prize** - ₹ 5100/- (Fifty one hundred)
- **Professor Ghasi Ram Malik Prize** - ₹ 1500/- (Fifteen hundred).
- **Professor K.C. Yadav Memorial Prize** - ₹ 1100/- (Eleven hundred).
- **Imarati Devi Memorial Prize** - ₹ 1100/- (Eleven hundred)

INSTRUCTIONS FOR BEST PAPER AWARDS:

- Best paper prize will be announced and given in the next Annual Session (9th Session) of HHC.
- Best paper award will be decided by the chair of the technical session and recommendation of the editorial board of the proceeding.
- Those who wish to submit their paper for best paper prize consideration should send their full paper within time. Details regarding the paper will be published in the Second circular to be published in the near future.


