





NORMS FOR RESEARCH PAPER

- The research paper should bear the full name/s of the author/s, their email ID/s, contact number and address (official and residential) on the first page.
- The paper should not exceed 3500 words including references/notes.
- Text for English- 12 font with double space of Times New Roman and for Hindi- Kruti dev 10.
- The abstract of the paper should not exceed more than 150 words.
- The paper should be based on original sources with new interpretations and in depth analysis.
- Full paper should be submitted in soft copy in words and pdf files.
- The papers should be sent ONLY on this email: hhcresearchpaper@gmail.com
- References and notes should be given in last page of your research paper with proper numbering e.g. 1, 2, 3.....
- The research papers should follow Chicago manual citation style: 16th edition.
- The maps, diagrams, figures and photographs should be listed and be in such forms as to be ready for the printing.
- Participants should be submitting their research paper with abstract by
 20 November, 2023. The papers received after the last date will not be entertained for presentation.
- The papers which are not found satisfactory by the expert committee will not be entertained for presentation.
- Only delegates (life or annual) of the Haryana History Congress can present their research paper in the conference.

Meals


